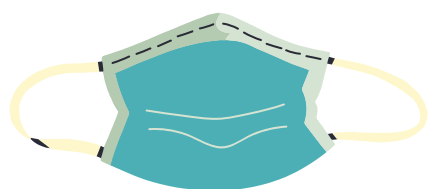


HOW TO CLEAN & DISINFECT TOOLS

SAFE TOOL HANDLING



Use Personal Protective Equipment

WASH YOUR HANDS OR USE HAND SANITIZER BEFORE & AFTER HANDLING TOOLS



Get trained on proper use of tools

CLEANING MATERIALS

Mild soap
Clean damp cloth
Diluted bleach solution



DO NOT USE conductive or corrosive materials

NEVER use flammable or combustible solvents around tools

TOOL CLEANING PROTOCOLS

Mild Soap & Rest Method

USE THIS METHOD FOR BATTERIES

Clean with mild soap and damp cloth.

Let the item rest for 3 days.

Wipe again with damp cloth (optional).

Mild Soap & Diluted Bleach Method

Clean the surface with mild soap & water.

Dip a clean cloth into diluted bleach solution & wring out.

Gently wipe handles, grasping surfaces & outer surfaces.

Do not allow liquids to flow into the tool.

Allow the surface to dry naturally.

AVOID TOUCHING YOUR FACE WITH UNWASHED HANDS



Immediately wash your hands after cleaning tools.

NEVER MIX BLEACH SOLUTION WITH ANY OTHER CLEANSER



TOOLS CONTAMINATED WITH BLOOD

- Advanced cleaning required.
- Follow OSHA bloodborne pathogen cleaning protocols.
- Anyone performing this work must be properly trained.
